






#### **Romanian Airports - Traffic evolution 1999-2019**






#### Romanian Airports - Airline market share by allocated capacity-2019











# Romanian Airports - Passengers Traffic forecast 2022-2040 PRUDENT Scenario

- CLJ airport's efforts to bring in new airlines and new routes with its strong incentives programme


Cluj "Avram Iancu" International Airport has won the **ATN Corporate Award** at the Air Transport Awards 2021.

The Air Transport 2021 Awards was organized by Hermes - Air Transport Organization, ATN - Air Transport News and ALA - Latin America Aeronoticias.




#### Cluj International Airport – Catchment area & Competition

- One of the fastest growing regional airports in South-Eastern Europe and the main airport of Transylvania
- 3 hours flying time to most of Europe
- 16 Romanian Airports high level of competition
- Hungarian airports (BUD & DEB) strong international competition
- 1 million people can reach the airport within 1 hour driving time and 2.5 million people can reach the airport within 2 hours
- Expanded catchment area more than 4
   million people within 200 km from the airport





#### Cluj International Airport – Evolution of air traffic 1996-2022





#### Cluj International Airport – Total passenger traffic figures 2019-2022






